Subsequent to a roll call vote in Regular Session on a motion made by Ellen Grieco, seconded by Kathie Steinberg, the School Committee <u>voted</u> unanimously (4-0) to enter Executive Session at 7:06 p.m. for the purposes of discussing strategy with respect to collective bargaining with the Custodians and Food Service workers, as permitted by M.G.L. c.30A, §21(a)(3), as such discussion in open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining position of the School Committee and an Executive Session is necessary to protect the bargaining position of the School Committee, discussing strategy with respect to collective bargaining related to healthcare with the WTA, WESA, Food Service, and Custodial Unions, as permitted by M.G.L. c.30A, §21(a)(3), as such discussion in open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining position of the School Committee and an Executive Session is necessary to protect the bargaining position of the School Committee.
