## **Post Graduate Preparation**

- **1.2.1** – Average score on SAT tests by subject, total – YES

- **1.2.3** – Percent of students enrolled in advanced classes at HS – YES
  - Flip order of 1.2.2 and 1.2.3
- **1.2.4** – Percent of students accepted to college and quality of college – YES
  - Using US News & World Report listing as a competitive metric
  - Listing 4-year private, public, 2-year
  - By major
  - By cost of college
  - Q: Where are children with IEPs going?
- **1.2.5** – Add alumni survey – YES
  - How well were students prepared for college?
  - What percentage of their tuition was covered by scholarship money?
  - What form will survey take: phone, written?
  - How frequently will survey be administered: every year, every other, ...?

  - Convert this to 1.3.1 ES, 1.3.2 MS, 1.3.3 HS
- **1.3.2** – Size, progress in % at/above standard rubric by grade and subject for each group
  - Folded into new 1.3.1-1.3.3 above
