MINUTES – WAYLAND SCHOOL COMMITTEE Special Meeting – October 15, 2020

A Joint Meeting of the Wayland School Committee and the Board of Health was held remotely on Thursday, October 15, 2020, at 10:30 A.M. broadcast by WayCAM in the Wayland Town Building.

Chair Jeanne Downs convened the meeting for the School Committee at 10:32 a.m. WayCAM recorded the meeting and it was livestreamed via ZOOM. 1. Discuss Metrics for Back to School Hybrid Mode Planned for October 19th:

Ruth Mori reported that the number of COVID cases are the same as last week. A discussion ensued about quarantining and the health department's role with families.

Arthur described the communication plan if a COVID case is found in the schools. Further discussion about how families are informed of a COVID case in a classroom took place. The Board of Health recommended that there be three levels of communications at all school buildings: building, class, close contacts. Ruth supported that level of communication. Arthur will rework the communication process to include those three levels of communication at all buildings.

Arthur reported the plan to focus on the goal of 100% compliance with health attestation completion. School nurses will focus on any "yes" answers on the attestation and Ruth will provide additional support as necessary. Administrative staff will follow up on non-completion of the attestation.

The Board of Health reviewed their recommendation from the previous week regarding the move to hybrid mode on October 19. After a brief discussion, the Board of Health confirmed their recommendation to move to hybrid mode on October 19. The Board also noted the importance of staying vigilant with all health and safety protocols.

Flu vaccines were discussed. Ruth noted that there is a system in place to track those who have not received a flu shot by December 31.
