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# The Challenge

- Maintain high quality of programming
  - Meet the need of the current waiting list of about 80 children
  - Meet predicted additional need for 40-50 children
  - Hire sufficient staff to meet the need
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# Considerations

In order to expand thoughtfully:

- Respectful of teacher need for classrooms after-school
  - Limit student locations for parents' convenience
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# The Collaboration

- Pat Keefe (WSCP) and Katherine Brenna (Recreation Department)
  - Leverage experience, skills and resources of Recreation Department in developing programming and in recruiting staff
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## The Structure

- WSCP will incorporate Recreation after-school programming under its umbrella with Pat Keefe supervising their work
  - Rec and WSCP will share the implementation of larger scale programming in sports, arts, science, and team-building
  - As is currently, K-3 will be at each elementary school, 4-8 at WMS
  - Will strive to offer 120-130 additional spots program-wide
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## **A Typical Day, K-3**

- 2:25** Check-in, Attendance and Recess
  - 3:00** Snack and activity choices
  - 3:30** First Pick-up; Activity Rotation #1
  - 4:00** Activity Rotation #2
  - 4:30** Second Pick-up; Activity Rotation #3
  - 5:00** Free Play Block and Homework
  - 5:30** Varied activities and Homework
  - 6:00** Final Pick-up
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## A Typical Day, 4-5

2:25	Check-in, attendance and recess (as possible)
2:35-2:50	Board bus to MS BASE (time depends on site)
3:00	Arrival at WMS and Recess
3:20	Snack and Activity choices
3:30	First pickup (if necessary); Activity
Block, Clubs	
4:30	<del>Second Pick-up; Varied activities &amp; Homework</del>

## A Typical Day, 6-8

3:15

Check-in, Attendance and Snack

3:30

Activity Block, including: Recess;

Crafts;

Clubs; Homework; Chromebooks

4:30

First Pick-up; Varied activities;

Homework

5:30

Varied activities and Homework

6:00

Final Pick-up

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# Sign-Up Process

Per day/per site caps set prior to the start of the registration process

- April 8-14:** On-line Registration for returning and FY19 Waitlist families
- April 26-30:** On-line Registration for new and Kindergarten families;
- If necessary, include disclaimer that not all registrants will be guaranteed enrollment
  - Include information about other other options such as Longfellow and possibly YMCA
- May 1:** Notify families who registered above the identified capacity
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# Challenge: Staff Recruitment Plans

- Aggressive recruitment of staff from FSU, Mass Bay, Bentley, Regis, Brandeis, Babson, Bridgewater State, Keefe Tech
  - Flexible opportunities for high school staff
  - More systematic recruitment of current and new district staff
  - Recruit staff from Rec summer staff
  - Recruit parents to work (not in the buildings where their children attend)
